L. Robert Bolling Scholarship Application

Student2Scholar is a Virginia nonprofit organization founded in 2021, providing scholarship resources to deserving high schoolers in the Greater Richmond Area. As part of this, Student2Scholar will annually offer its own line of scholarship(s) exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.

Student2Scholar's scholarship review committee will review the applications and will award one scholarship for at least **\$1,000.00** for the **AY 2022-23**. These are non-renewable.

Students are selected primarily on the basis of merit; however, financial need may be a factor in finalizing the recipient. Merit is demonstrated through academic achievement (GPA, class rank, standardized test scores) and community involvement (extracurricular activities, leadership experience, community service). Financial need is established via FAFSA's Student Aid Report (SAR), post-secondary costs, and possibly the illustration of any further financial considerations.

All completed scholarship applications must be **received by email or mail (top of application) by April 30, 2022**. Applications received incomplete or after April 30 will not be considered. This includes not answering all applicable questions and not attaching all required documentation. Students are encouraged to submit their applications and supporting documents as soon as possible. The committee will evaluate each completed application and determine the rank of each applicant at the annual scholarship review. After a final ranking has been established, the committee will conduct select interviews to determine the final scholarship winner. All **notifications will be sent via email**.

All monies will be paid directly to the institution where the recipient will attend after receipt of verification that the applicant is a registered student. The final winner will be offered a prestigious position on the Student2Scholar Community Advisory Council for one year following notification.

Eligibility

- Current high school Seniors with post-secondary educational aspirations.
- Currently residing or attending a high school in the Greater Richmond Area (Richmond, Petersburg, Hopewell, Colonial Heights, Amelia, Caroline, Charles City, Chesterfield, Dinwiddie, Goochland, Hanover, Henrico, King William, New Kent, Powhatan, Prince George, and Sussex)

Scholarship Honoree

This year, Student2Scholar has chosen L. Robert Bolling to be the honoree of our annual scholarship. Mr. Bolling is a staple in the Richmond community.

A native of RVA, Bolling earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science in 1982 from Amherst College in Amherst, Massachusetts.

Mr. Bolling spent 14 years with the Virginia Department of Health, starting there in 1986 as a statistical analyst. He rose to senior planner and was appointed director of the Office of Minority Health in 1992. After his work with the state, he served in management positions, mostly in finance and development, with groups including Youth Matters through the Greater Richmond Chamber and nonprofits such as Boaz & Ruth and The Healing Place.



In 2012, Mr. Bolling was named Chief Executive Officer of ChildSavers, the only nonprofit in Virginia using a coordinated prevention and intervention model to address children's mental health, preparing them for lifelong learning and helping them recover from trauma.

Mr. Bolling's radiant attitude, inspirational leadership, and community results have made him a RVA community leader. Student to Scholar is honoring Mr. Bolling with his very own scholarship. Mr. Bolling will be invited to be directly involved in the reviewing of applications, interviewing of top applicants, and the presenting of the award.
